1) ROAD TO QUILTING (☞)

Calling all beginners! The “Road to Quilting” is a class designed especially for you. You’ll learn all the secrets to reading a pattern. We’ll take the mystery out of rotary cutting and the ¼” seam allowance. Learn how proper pressing can be a quilter’s best friend. You’ll also prepare a quilt sandwich (sorry, it’s not edible) and learn to do some simple machine quilting. This hands-on class meets for four weeks. The class fee includes the pattern and 1 ½ yards of fabric.

2) PERFECT POINTS TABLE RUNNER (☞✓) **NEW**

Have you caught the quilting bug? We’ve got the cure! The next step in quilting is learning to make quarter-square and half-square triangles. This hands-on class will have you making both types quickly and easily. You’ll turn them into pieced blocks and set them on point to make a lovely table runner. When you are finished with this class, you’ll be ready for all types of quilting projects. Prerequisite: Road to Quilting class or completion of a quilt. (3 weeks)

You will be shown several methods for applying binding both by hand and machine. You will also be shown how to make and attach personalized quilt labels.
